Program Details

- **Enrollment Deadline: May 24, 2019**
- **Session Dates: June 3, 2019 to July 25, 2019**
- **June 17, 2019-Last day to drop w/o grade transcribed**
- Students are allowed to enroll in one .5 course or one 1.0 credit course.
- Summer School is fee based per .5 credit
- Students **MUST** have access to a computer and the Internet
- Parents and Students that are new to MVA **MUST** attend the orientation in Manhattan on June 3, 2019
- Students **MUST** complete all course work by July 25, 2019
- High School Students **MUST** attend final exams on June 27th (1st sem.) and July 25th (2nd sem.)
- Students will need to spend approximately 4-5 hours per day to complete their course on time

Fees

.5 credit = \$300

June 10, 2019: last day for a fee refund
