ParentSquare is the school communication platform this year. An account for each parent is automatically generated with enrollment, using the parent's preferred email address and phone number.

Here's what parents/guardians can do with ParentSquare:

- Receive messages from the school via email, text, or app notification
- Choose to receive information as it comes or all at once with a daily digest at 6 pm
- Communicate in your preferred language -ParentSquare works with Google Translate and has access to over 100+ languages
- Comment on school postings to engage with your school community
- Direct message staff
- · Participate in group messages
- · Sign up to volunteer

<u>ParentSquare</u> connects teachers and parents by simplifying the communication process. Instead of trying to reach each other via email or cell phone,

teachers and parents can easily communicate through the ParentSquare platform. And instead of having numerous communications tools among schools, all schools will be using ParentSquare.
